

ARCA Guidelines for Starting a Student Chapter

- 1. The student who is interested in starting the chapter must find a faculty member who is willing to serve as the advisor for the ARCA student chapter.
- 2. Both the student and the advisor must be or become ARCA members.
- 3. The student and the faculty advisor must work together to develop by-laws that govern the ARCA student chapter.

- 4. The established student chapter must be recognized as a student organization on their campus.
- 5. Submit your ARCA student chapter by-laws to the ARCA Student Representative for review, Alexis Duggan duggan138@gmail.com and copy ARCA Office Manager arcaoffice@arcaweb.org for record-keeping purposes.
- 6. The by-laws will then be passed ARCA Executive Council to be voted on.
- 7. The faculty and student will be contacted once the by-laws have been approved.
